HELP WANTED: Hosts, hostesses, pre-fair and post-fair volunteer helpers! We need you – to help set up displays, accept entries, scribes for judges, and function as hosts of the area during Fair. No prior experience necessary, some training may be provided.

GENERAL OPEN CLASS DEPARTMENT RULES

- 1. These rules apply to all departments in Open Class unless changes are noted under special department rules.
- 2. NO EXHIBITS MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS BEFORE 10:00 A.M., MONDAY FOLLOWING CLOSE OF THE FAIR.
- 3. Age break for exhibitors as follows: (unless otherwise noted under special department rules)
 - Children 10 years and under
 - Junior 11 through 17 years
 - Adult 18 through 59 years
 - Sr. Citizen 60 years and over
- 4. Removal of any exhibit, prior to dismissal time, from display area will be seen as a final act and will result in immediate forfeiture of all premiums, points, and privileges by the exhibitor. Further, exhibitors may be suspended from future exhibiting at the Kitsap Fair.
- 5. No premium money will be paid in Open Class exhibit departments.
- 6. Each entry must be the work of the exhibitor.
- 7. Only one entry per lot number will be accepted from any one exhibitor, unless otherwise noted under special department rules.
- 8. No professional may enter an exhibit in any department unless allowed by individual department rules.
- 9. Work entered at any previous Kitsap Fair is not eligible.

10. Late entries CANNOT AND WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Please read the Exhibitor's Guide carefully.

11. Each exhibitor should check entry tag to insure it is marked properly as to each age group, division, class, and lot number.

12. Please do not bring in items that have no divisions or lot numbers, as they cannot be judged.

- 13. The Kitsap Fair cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to entries. The utmost care will be exercised to protect all exhibits.
- 14. Rules and regulations exist to ensure fairness and equality in judging and are for the protection of the exhibitor. If you wish to see changes, please inform the department superintendent in writing so suggestions may be evaluated and included in future planning.
- 15. Each exhibitor will receive one 5-day admission pass to the Fair. This pass must be picked up on the day of entry. <u>One pass per exhibitor</u>. Exhibitors must provide an entry card or entry form, to pick up their pass. Exhibitors will also be given the opportunity to purchase a 5-day parking pass at a reduced rate. This pass must be purchased on the day of entry.

HOME ARTS – RULES

- 1. Items submitted must be clean, pressed (if appropriate), odor free, and in good condition. If they have been used, items must be in like-new condition and must have been finished within the last year. Items not meeting these criteria will not be accepted.
- 2. Entries may be placed into a different class or lot at the discretion of the superintendent, judge, or supervisor.
- 3. A maximum of three (3) entries per lot per person is allowed.
- 4. The exhibit tag must be in the name of the person who created the item.
- 5. Unfinished items will not be accepted: finishing techniques are part of the judging process.
- 6. Small items (less than 6" in size overall) must be attached to a piece of felt, board, or other foundation (securing to a larger background piece or foundation will help prevent loss of a small item). The item must be attached in a way that the judge can move/remove the item to examine it.
- 7. Pictures must be framed. Professional framing is permissible. Glass or plastic is optional. All framed entries must have a **sturdy wire hanger** (no string or self leveling hangers allowed).
- 8. Display of any entry is at the discretion of the Home Arts Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent.
- 9. "Just the 2 of Us" is a category open to entries made by children in the "Youth" age group (10 and under) made with significant help or supervision by another.

- 10. Your entries will be handled and overseen with loving care and concern to the best of our ability, but we cannot be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
- 11. Items may be entered "for display only" and not judged.
- 12. The entry's age category is determined by the age of the exhibitor when the item was finished, not the exhibitor's age at the time of entry.
- 13. The Home Arts Department is for <u>amateurs</u> to compete and exhibit their work. If you gross more than \$1500 per year from the sale or production (full or partial) of items that can be entered in a Home Arts class, or earn more than \$1500 per year as an instructor or teacher in that class, any items you enter **in that class** must be entered in the "Professional" category.

Examples:

- You earn more than \$1500 a year doing machine quilting for other people's quilts. If you enter a quilt that has been machine quilted by you, it must be entered in the Professional category. You may enter a quilt in the "hand quilted" or "tied" classes as an amateur.
- You teach sewing classes or workshops and earn more than \$1500 a year. Any items you enter in the "Sewing" class must be entered in the "Professional" category.
- You crochet items and sell them on Etsy or in craft markets and earn more than \$1500 per year. Any item you enter in the "Crochet" class must be entered in the "Professional" category.

JUDGING

- 1. Judges are highly accredited and work within their field of expertise.
- 2. The Danish System is used for judging. The Danish System is a system of judging where each item is judged on its **individual merits** and **not compared** to other entries.
- Each qualified entry will receive a ribbon placing of blue, red, white, or green. Ribbons for Best of Class, Judge's Choice, Superintendent's Choice, Best Use of Fair Theme, and other special awards may also be given. At the discretion of the judges, not all special wards may be given.
- 4. The decisions of the judges are final.
- 5. The judge's scoring sheet will be attached to the entry, and is only available for viewing when the item is picked up on Monday after the Fair is closed.
