DETAILS

PURCHASING OUTRIGHT

Purchasing an animal for standard processing and obtaining meat for the family freezer. This will involve additional costs for initial processing, cutting, and wrapping.

- Smoking/curing costs are in addition to cut/wrap costs.
- Poultry and rabbits are sold in a pen of 3 or sold as singles.

SPLITTING PURCHASES

- One or more buyers/businesses may split the purchase of an animal. Buyers must make their own arrangements to do this and must bid as one entity.

TURNING

- Selling the animal back to the processor at the pre-determined "turn" price. Price will be posted at the sale.
- Example:
 - Buyer bids \$4.25/lb. on a 1,200 lb. steer, "turn" price is \$1.25 /lb.
 - $\$4.25 \times 1,200 \text{ lbs.} = \$5,100$
 - $\$1.25 \times 1,200 \text{ lbs.} = \underline{-\$1,500}$
 - $\$3,600$
 - Buyer cost is \$3,600 to support the steer.
